<u>Semi-hardy</u> vegetables can tolerate light frosts - from 29 to 32 degrees:

- Lettuce and gourmet salad greens
- Radicchio
- Rutabaga
- Salsify
- Swiss chard

Summer Vegetables

Plant after the threat of frost is past. Need warm weather (65 to 90 degrees) to grow and are killed by frost:

- Beans
- Corn
- Cucumber
- Eggplant
- Gourds
- Melons
- Okra
- Peppers
- Pumpkins
- Southern peas
- Summer squash
- Sweet Potatoes
- Tomatoes
